RE: North Tahoe Public Utility District Urban Water Management Plan 2015 Update

Dear Lynn Nolan,

The North Tahoe Public Utility District (NTPUD) is preparing its Urban Water Management Plan (UWMP) 2015 Update. The State of California Urban Water Management Planning Act (Act) (Water Code Sec. 10610-10656) requires each urban water supplier with 3,000 or more connections, or which supplies at least 3,000 acre-feet per year of water, to submit UWMPs to the California Department of Water Resources (DWR) every five years.

According to the Act, **“Each urban water supplier shall coordinate the preparation of its plan with other appropriate agencies in the area, including other water suppliers that share a common source, water management agencies, and relevant public agencies, to the extent practicable”** and **“Each urban water supplier shall encourage the active involvement of diverse social, cultural, and economic elements of the population within the service area prior to and during the preparation of the plan....”**. The NTPUD invites you to participate in the preparation of NTPUD’s UWMP 2015 Update. The NTPUD Board of Directors will hold a public hearing and adopt the UWMP on June 13, 2017 at 4:00 p.m. at the North Tahoe Event Center located at 8318 North Lake Blvd., Kings Beach, CA. The Draft UWMP will be available for review and comment on May 31, 2017 at the NTPUD Administrative Office (875 National Ave., Tahoe Vista, CA) and on the NTPUD website ([www.ntpud.org](http://www.ntpud.org)).
